Quarterly Report "Memorial Site" Project Ottawa; 05/06/2023

Dear friends, I am pleased to provide you with an update on the activities undertaken during the last three months for our memorial site construction project:

- 1. During the commemoration ceremonies in the Ottawa-Gatineau region, the Humura committee emphasized the critical importance of contributing to the construction of the memorial site.
- 2. On April 14, 2023, the Humura Association committee held a meeting with representatives from Heritage Canada and Fathom Design Studio from Dartmouth, Nova Scotia. The committee presented the project's history, the implementation plan, and the support required, including funds for the project manager, feasibility study, and logistics.

Representatives from Fathom Design Studio, renowned for their experience in similar projects, expressed interest in assisting with the development of the feasibility study once funds become available. The requested funds amount to \$60,000.

Following the meeting, Heritage Canada representatives committed to responding to our request within a few weeks.

- 3. On June 15, 2023, our committee is scheduled to meet with the honorable Arielle Kayabaga to provide an update on the project's progress and seek her support.
- 4. Recently, we have sent emails to federal MPs in the National Capital Region requesting meetings to garner their support.

5. Regarding fundraising, your committee has received \$800 in the last three months. We encourage you to continue your contributions to ensure the timely completion of this project.
